- We kicked off our theme of Fairytales this month with Goldilocks and the Three Bears. The children had a blast acting out the story in Dramatic Play with the setting of the three bears house.
- As part of our social and emotional learning, we explored fair ways to play such as trading, taking turns, and sharing. When we were outside, we overheard children saying they were going to take turns. First, they would run on top of the tractor tire, then run across the bridge. This was a perfect example of children wanting to do different things but still playing together. School is more fun when we have friends and include everyone.
- We focused on our last letters Y and Z during show and tell and practiced our writing skills in our Get Set for School Books. The children pointed out that the similarities were that both letters had diagonal lines and little lines when we build the letters using wood pieces.
- One day this week when we came in from outside, a kiddo looked at his teacher wide-eyed and said "I smell bacon! Where is Charlotte (our pet pig)?" We assured the child that our pet Charlotte was safe and sound in the barn.
